Bilingual (Spanish/English) LCSW with 26 years of experience. Faculty for 8 years a Bay Area MFT Program and graduate-level instructor at UC Berkeley's School of Social Welfare. Has trained clinicians throughout California including at Fred Finch Youth Center, A Better Way, Seneca, and Napa County Child Welfare.

Her clinical work is grounded in a psychodynamic lens, informed by awareness of immigration trauma, intergenerational and historical trauma, and trauma-informed care, and practiced through a liberation- and justice-informed approach with Latine and other historically oppressed communities.

About This Training

The Latine community often experiences erasure and invisibility when considering the racial impact on Latine bodies. This course will highlight and bring forward the common wounds experienced by Latines and Latinas navigating their physical existence within a society shaped by colonial beauty standards that normalize and prefer Whiteness.

This training will address how this racialized trauma impacts psychological well-being, but also how it is stored, performed, felt, and regulated through the body. This training introduces a liberation-informed framework for recognizing how colonial body standards, colorism, and hypersexualization live in the body and activate shame responses.

Every training offered through Roots in Healing Training Institute brings a systemic perspective to clinical practice because the individual cannot be understood apart from the forces that shaped them.

Learning Objectives

By the end of this training, participants will be able to:

1. Describe the concept of "paradoxical body image" and explain how Latina/Latine clients may navigate two competing, colonially rooted beauty standards simultaneously.
2. Identify the historical and colonial origins of hypersexualization and body-based stigma affecting Latina and Latine clients.
3. Distinguish how colorism produces distinct forms of racialized body harm across the range of Latine skin tones.
4. Recognize clinical presentations of body-based shame and nervous system activation that may stem from this paradox.
5. Apply a self-examination framework to identify their own embodied reactions and countertransference when this material arises in session.
